RESEARCH AND INDUSTRY INFORMATION

- NAREIT develops and communicates high quality, rigorous analytical research to global institutional and individual investors, policymakers and media. Research is developed both internally and with recognized consultants.
- NAREIT's sponsored research program has engaged a number of highly respected

academics as well as a variety of consultants and other organizations, including Ibbotson Associates, the American Real Estate Society, the Real Estate Research Institute, MIT Center for Real Estate, the American Real Estate and Urban Economics Association and FPL Associates Compensation.

- To promote real estate investment through REITs and publicly traded real estate securities, NAREIT partners with FTSE Group and the European Public Real Estate Association (EPRA) to calculate and disseminate equity performance benchmarks for stock exchange-listed REITs and real estate securities in the U.S. and worldwide. Two complimentary e-mails providing summary information with respect to these benchmarks are:

NAREIT Daily Domestic Returns, detailing the FTSE NAREIT U.S. Real Estate Index Series comprehensive family of REIT performance indices measured over various time periods and different property sectors; and

NAREIT Daily Global Returns, detailing the FTSE EPRA/NAREIT Global Real Estate Index Series indices tracking performance of stock exchange-listed REITs and real estate companies in North America, Europe and Asia.

- NAREIT complimentary tools include:

REITWatch®, a monthly online statistical report summarizing U.S. REIT capital market activity, industry and sector performance, as well as trends in the U.S. REIT and publicly traded real estate industry and the U.S. economy;

Online Handbook, an online membership directory, updated weekly, which profiles each corporate member in detail and



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allows searches for both corporate and associate members based on several criteria;

Federal REIT Tax Compendium, an online, interactive research tool for all IRS rulings and regulations in the REIT tax area, including summaries of all IRS REIT guidance pronouncements and a key word index;

REIT members. Biennially, this survey includes either information pertaining to employee benefit programs or information relating to board compensation; and

Insurance Survey, NAREIT's survey every few years of information on premiums and scope of coverage for directors and officers, environmental, property and other types of insurance obtained by NAREIT U.S. corporate members.

- NAREIT's online data library is a comprehensive source for industry performance statistics and capital market activities.

POLICY AND POLITICS

NAREIT represents your interests before national and state policy makers.

- NAREIT helps to lead the Coalition to Insure Against Terrorism, which is currently seeking the extension of the federal public-private terrorism insurance partnership beyond 2014.
- For decades, NAREIT has worked to obtain advantageous provisions to REIT tax rules through enactment of the REIT Simplification Act of 1997, the REIT Modernization Act of 1999, the REIT Improvement Act of 2004, and the REIT Investment Diversification and Empowerment Act (RIDEA) of 2008 among many other important pieces of legislation.
- NAREIT works with its members to obtain favorable guidance from the SEC, IRS and other Executive Branch agencies. For example, NAREIT successfully worked with the SEC to change a proposed rule that would have stopped UPREITs from efficiently accessing debt markets, and worked with the IRS to better allow REITs to acquire distressed debt instruments and to invest extra cash in money market funds,



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- NAREIT works with its members to represent the perspective of the real estate industry before the Financial Accounting Standards Board (FASB). Recent successes include favorable changes to proposals regarding lessor accounting, investment companies and discontinued operations.
- NAREIT closely worked with EPRA and BPF to change the regulatory implementation of the European Union's Alternative Investment Fund Managers Directive so that it should not impact most U.S. REITs.

GLOBAL INITIATIVES

NAREIT represents your interests before national and international regulatory and standards-setting organizations as well as with international alliance partners.

- NAREIT led an international effort which successfully modified the Organization for Economic Cooperation and Development's model tax treaty to achieve uniform tax treatment for cross-border REIT investments around the world.
- NAREIT is working with international real estate organizations to develop industry consensus on reporting standards proposed by the FASB and the International Accounting Standards Board, including consensus on a global real estate industry financial statement model.
- NAREIT works closely with REESA, the Real Estate Equity Securitization Alliance, comprised of the Asia Pacific Real Estate Association (APREA), the Association for Real Estate Securitization (ARES), the British Property Federation (BPF), EPRA, NAREIT, the Property Council of Australia (PCA), and the Real Property Association of Canada (REALpac), to further the interests of REITs and income-producing real estate around the world.



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
